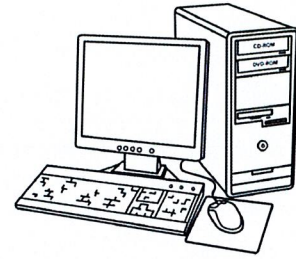
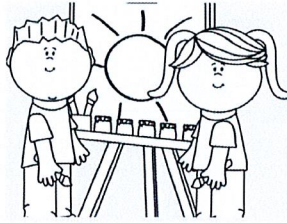

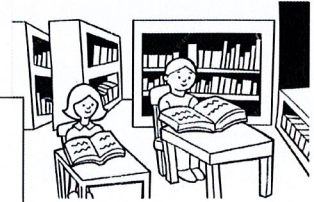
Dear Parents,
