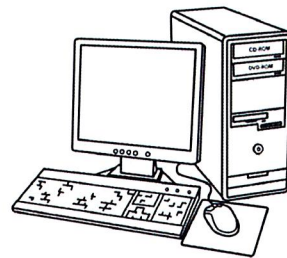
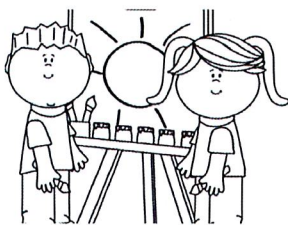


Special Areas – 2nd Grade

QUARTER NOTE = GREEN 

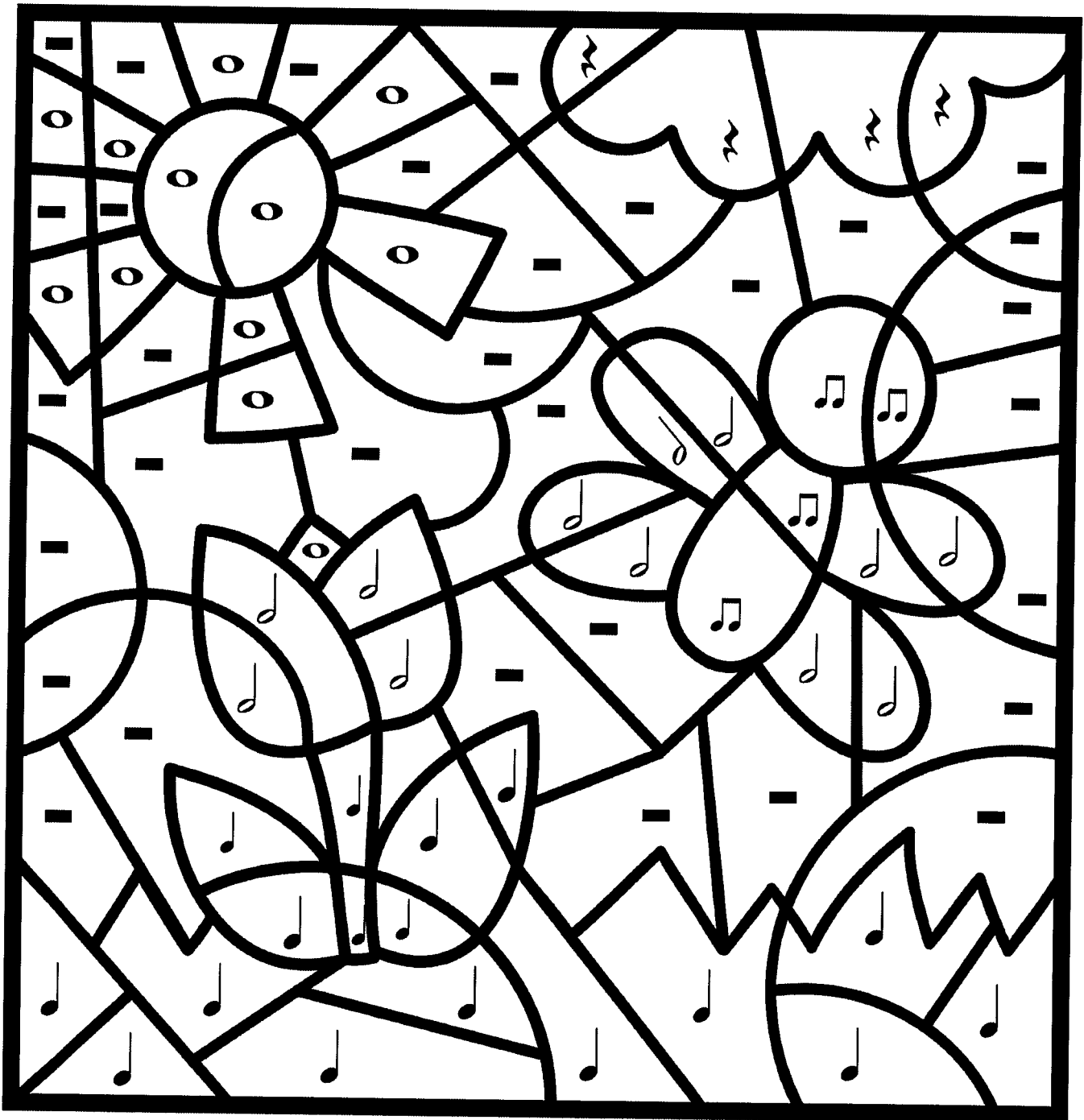
HALF REST = BLUE 

QUARTER REST = WHITE 

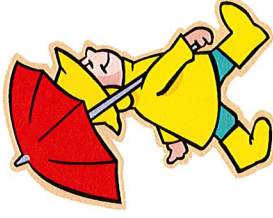

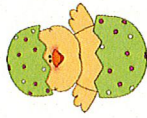
