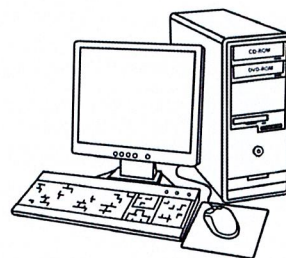
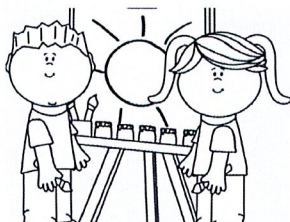


Special Areas – 2nd Grade
