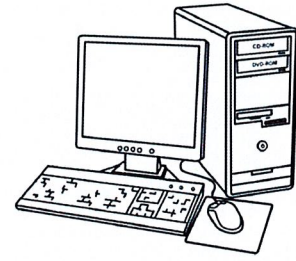
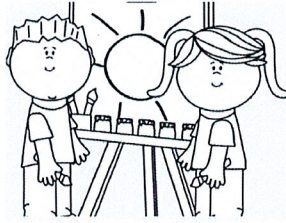

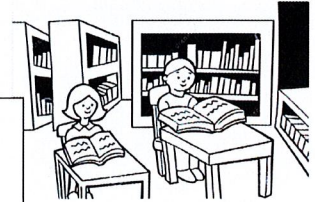
Dear Parents,

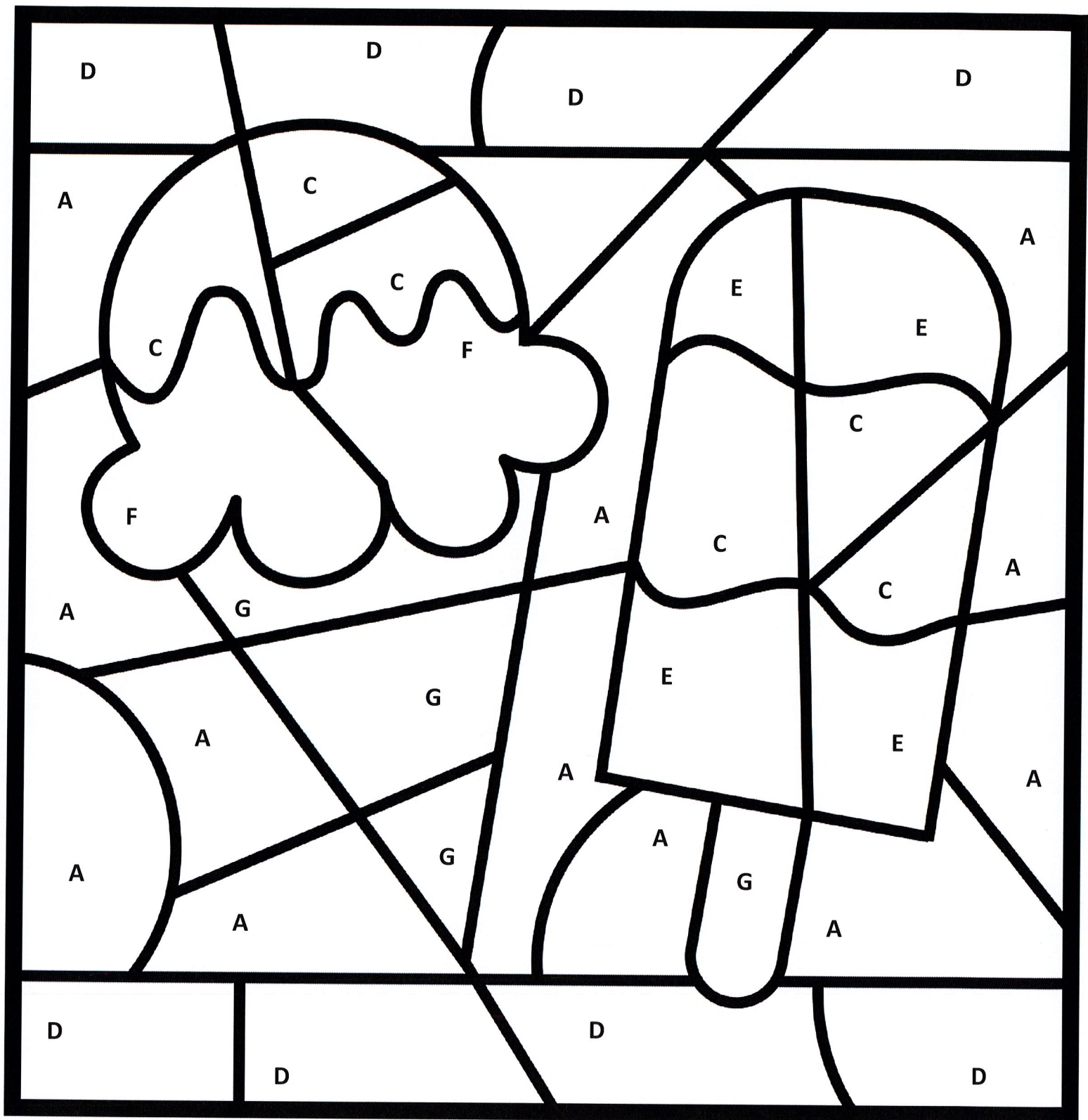
