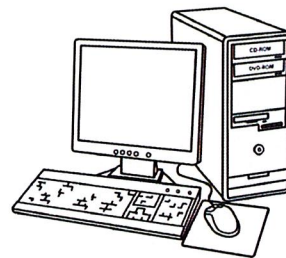
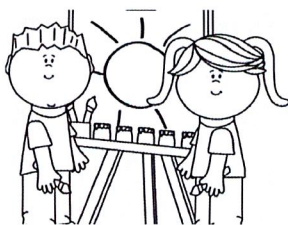


Special Areas – 4th Grade

Art – Mrs. Lechner (1 page)

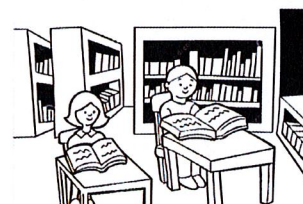
Computers – Mrs. Reed (same as last month)
