Following this page, you’ll see a calendar with weekly (and extra) activities. At the end of this packet is the activity log to fill out and return for grading purposes.

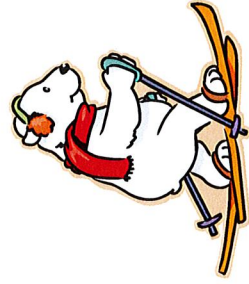
Thank you so much for all you’re doing, and please reach out at any time if I can help in any way. And remember: We WILL get through this – together, but apart! ☺

Concert Ab Scale Exercise

Find your instrument, and begin practicing your **Concert Ab scale**. This doesn't mean everyone is playing an "Ab" scale - it means all instruments will sound the same when we play it together in band. This is just like how we learned the Concert Bb scale - just a new one!

Percussionists, practice all the percussion parts for now.

The musical score is arranged in two systems. The first system contains staves for Flute, Clarinet in Bb, Alto Sax., Horn in F, Trumpet in Bb, Trombone, and Baritone (B.C.). The second system contains staves for Triangle, Tambourine, Snare Drum, and Bass Drum. All instruments are in 4/4 time. The key signature has three flats (Bb, Eb, Ab). The melody for the woodwinds and brass is: G4 (half), A4-B4 (quarter), C5 (quarter), B4-A4 (quarter), G4 (half). 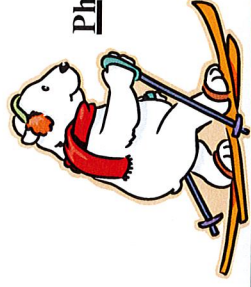
