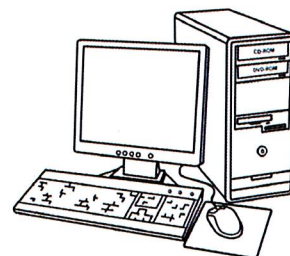
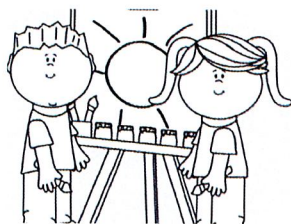

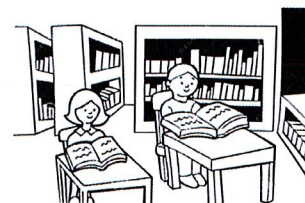


Dear Parents,
