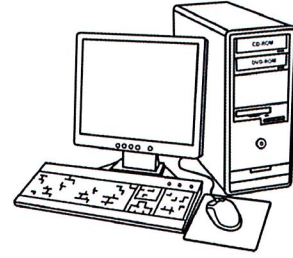
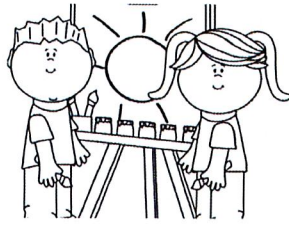


Special Areas – Kindergarten
