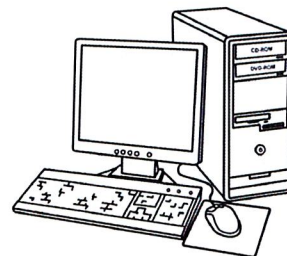
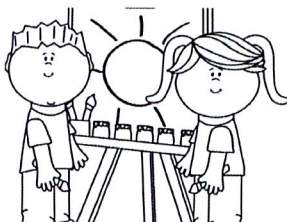


Special Areas – Kindergarten

In this packet, you will find work for the month of **December** from:

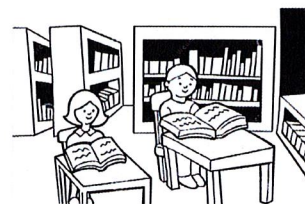

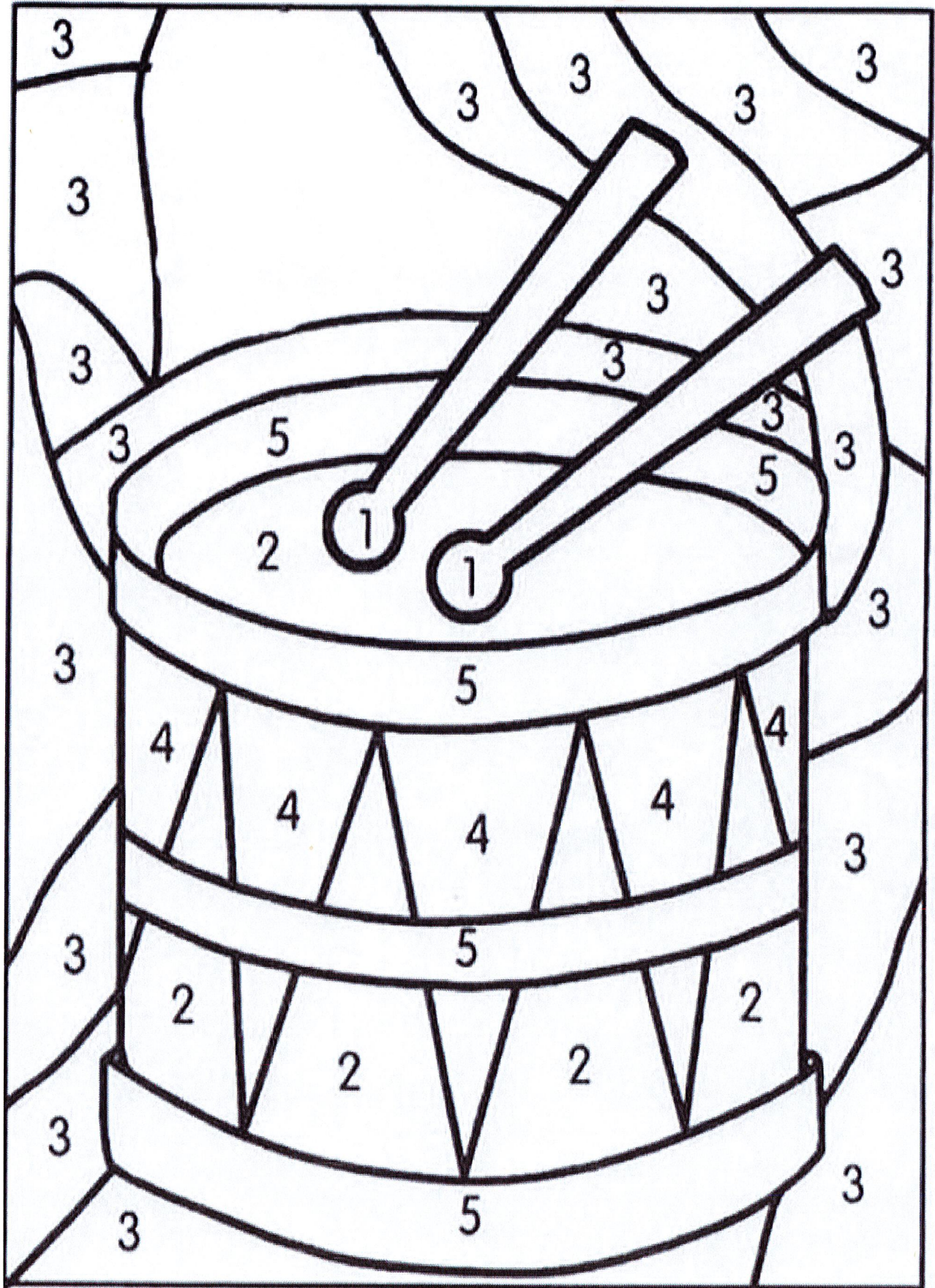
