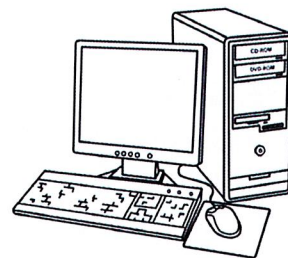
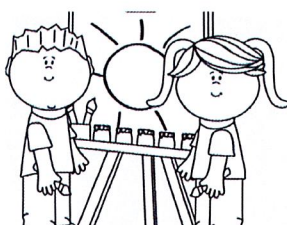


Special Areas – Kindergarten

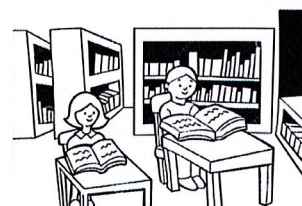
