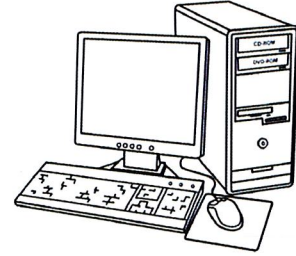
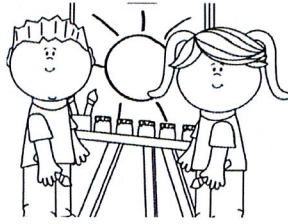


Special Areas – Kindergarten

In this packet, you will find work for the month of **October** from:

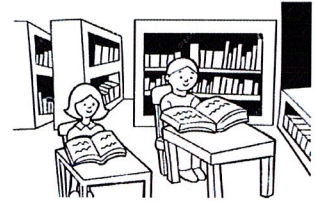

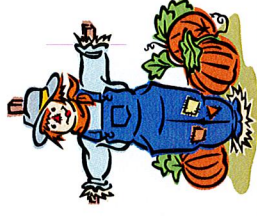

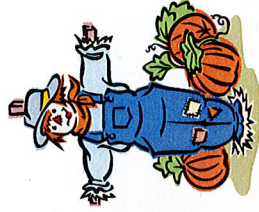

Every activity in the packet does not need to be completed in order for me to give sufficient grades.

If you can't email it, you can send the hard copies back to school, in the envelope they came in.

This packet is due by October 31st, and a new packet will be sent to you for November.

I also sent home an "Instrument Kit" this month! It includes: Rhythms sticks, maracas, tambourine, scarf, pencil (to be used as a triangle – more info soon!), pool noodles (scrapers), and bells! Some of these items will be used this month, and others as the school year goes on. Please keep this kit in a safe place, and feel free to use it for our music activities - or just for fun!

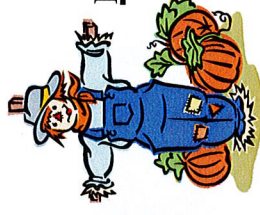
